

Asclepias incarnata
Swamp Milkweed



A native perennial with pink flowers which are attractive to butterflies as nectar and larval food. Good plant for garden beds and borders as well as naturalistic settings. Prefers full sun, and as the name implies, wet soil – but grows nicely in drier, well drained soils. Do not dig from wild as the long taproot makes transplanting difficult.

Height: 1' – 2 ½'.
