White Indigo



Baptisia alba is a herbaceous perennial, native to the southeastern United States, especially in longleaf pine sandhills. Attractive bushy shape has the appearance of a shrub with showy white flower spikes in summer, blue-green foliage, and blue-gray stems. White Indigo requires patience to establish as it forms a long taproot, but is long lived once that takes place. Do not transplant *B. alba* after it becomes well established (because of taproot.) Drought tolerant. Prefers sandy, well drained soil; responds to regular watering. Requires full sun to light shade.

Height: 3' - 4' Spread: 3' - 4'
